\$2000.00 not needed for other purposes.

For student labor during the vacation period pasted for
services rendered by John Monhart, a pupil, who assisted
the Disciplinarians in systematizing work in connection
with the proper discipline of male pupils of this school.

This pupil was not able to go out under the Outing
System to earn wages on account of being needed for the
work above specified. The services rendered were for 40
days at .75 cents per day - - - - - \$30.00
