The Office has received your letter dated September 30, 1910, requesting authority for your enrollment at the Carlisle Indian School, Pennsylvania, and submitting therewith your application as suggested by Superintendent Friedman in his letter dated September 9, which you also enclosed.

In reply you are advised that in view of the fact that you are a member of the Chickasaw tribe, and in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the Office for the enrollment of children of non-Indians and of unrestricted Indians of the Five Civilized Tribes of Oklahoma in Indian Schools, the authority requested by you will be granted, provided you pay your tuition fee at the Carlisle Indian School, which amounts to \$167 per annum.

If you decide to enroll under these conditions send your application, which is herewith returned to you, to Mr. Friedman
