This is to report that Wesley Twomoons, enrolled here from the Tongue River Agency in Montana, died
on September the 17th, as is indicated in a communication
that was handed to me by Dr. Allen, the Visiting School
Physician, as follows:

"Wesley Twomoons was admitted to the School Hospital on September 15th. He died September 17th. The diagnosis was double pneumonia; secondary, renal and cardiac insufficiency."

At the request of the parents the remains were shipped to the Tongue River Agency, accompanied by the sister of the young man who was also a student at this school.
