Sir:

Referring to Office letter of June the 14th,  
I respectfully report that Anna Melton left here on  
that same date for her home and that she provided funds  
for her transportation.

Reporting further as was directed in Office  
letter referred to above, this is to state that Anna  
and Clara Melton were enrolled here from September the  
11th of 1911 to June the 13th, last, and their sister  
Cora from September the 11th to May the 3rd, last. The  
Melton sisters paid their tuition in quarterly install-  
ments of \$41.75 each.

Newton Thompson, Ella Starr and Tom Starr,  
other members of the Five Civilized Tribes enrolled here,  
deposited an amount of \$167.00 each when their names  
were taken up on the school rolls.

George Manawa, the only other student enrolled here who is a member of the Five Tribes, has deposited two amounts of \$167.00 each for his tuition. The same has not been paid, however, for the period from April the 18th, last, to the present time, but the matter has been referred to the District Agent in charge of George's affairs and will probably be adjusted without delay.

As it is believed best to have payments made in advance by students who pay their tuition I shall require that such deposits shall be made by all students who are enrolled under this arrangement. Such action seems to be the only one whereby the matter can be handled to best advantage.

Sir:-

The Office has received a letter from Anna Melton asking if her transportation can be paid from Carlisle to her home in Oklahoma. This pupil was enrolled pursuant to authority granted by Office letter of December 30, 1911, upon the understanding that she should pay tuition and also her own transportation. The Office would not be justified in making an exception in her case to the general rule as to pupils from the Five Civilized Tribes. Please so advise her.

In this connection please advise the Office what other pupils from the Five Civilized Tribes are included in your enrollment, what amount for tuition they have paid in each case, and how this is being paid, whether in installments or otherwise. It is assumed that you would make the same charge for these Indians as other non-Indian pupils received at the school. Please advise if this is so, and also if you have now any children from the Five Civilized Tribes who are not paying tuition.

Dear Sir:

After hearing <sup>heard</sup> your address, and lives our diplomas. I can't feel you will be indifferent to the **cause** of an Indian who is seeking your help.

I came here in Sept. with my two sisters. we are Cherokees from Oklahoma. we paid our ways here and have been charged board since we came.

We have paid for one half year. the money we saved and worked for before we came. We want to go home in June as we can bear the expenses no longer and we have finished most of the work. Will the Gov. pay our ways back? I would like to go on the cutting but I couldn't make expenses so I don't think I shall.

I was told that a letter came to the office saying we wouldn't have to pay board. Could this be a mistake as we are still charged? How is it that some of the Cherokees from our same place are not charged and we are? And too may I ask, if the money has been paid in will it be refunded?

You will do me a great favor if you answer these questions directly to me and not through the office. Hoping you will understand the feeling which prompts me to write this. Thanking you in advance for any favors you may show us -
