Sir:

Referring to Office letter of June the 14th,

I respectfully report that Anna Melton left here on
that same date for her home and that she provided funds
for her transportation.

Reporting further as was directed in Office letter referred to above, this is to state that Anna and Clara Melton were enrolled here from September the 11th of 1911 to June the 13th, last, and their sister Cora from September the 11th to May the 3rd, last. The Melton sisters paid their tuition in quarterly installments of \$41.75 each.

Newton Thompson, Ella Starr and Tom Starr, other members of the Five Civilized Tribes enrolled here, deposited an amount of \$167.00 each when their names were taken up on the school rolls.

George Manawa, the only other student enrolled here who is a member of the Five Tribes, has deposited two amounts of \$167.00 each for his tuition. The same has not been paid, however, for the period from April the 18th, last, to the present time, but the matter has been referred to the District Agent in charge of George's affairs and will probably be adjusted without delay.

As it is believed best to have payments made in advance by students who pay their tuition I shall require that such deposits shall be made by all students who are enrolled under this arrangement. Such action seems to be the only one whereby the matter can be handled to best advantage.

It is assumed that you would make the same charge for these Indians as other non-Indian pupils received at the school. Please advise if this is so, and also if you have now any children from the Five Civilized Tribes who are not paying tuition.
