The office has your letter of February 1, 1912, suggesting a plan whereby your sisters, Elizabeth age 17, and Martha age 15, may enroll at Carlisle School during the coming fall.

The Office understands from your letter that you will take the girls to Philadelphia yourself about the middle of March for treatment at Dr. Fox's hospital, so they will be ready to start in school at Carlisle in the fall. The Office has no objection to this if the girls are able to pass the physical examination at the end of their treatment by Dr. Fox and can satisfy the Superintendent at Carlisle as to all other requirements.

It is suggested, however, that you take up this matter with the Superintendent there, so that he may determine for you positively whether these girls are eligible in all respects. If they are acceptable to him,

there would then be but one question to decide later, viz:
