Sir:

In answer to your letter of October 8, relative to the enrollment of your daughter at Carlisle Indian School, you are advised that the Office cannot transport pupils to a distant State who are under 14 years of age, but it is permissible to transport them to an adjoining State under the following provision of law:

"No pupil under fourteen may be transferred at Government expense to a distant school, i. e., to a school beyond the boundaries of the State in which the parents live, or the adjoining State."

As South Dakota is an adjoining State, if your daughter will consent to attend the Rapid City School in that State there would be no objection to enrolling her there, with the consent of the Superintendent of the school.

The matter has been taken up with the Superintendent of the Rapid City School with a view to sending your daughter there, and he will communicate with you regarding her enrollment.
