Sir:

It is respectfully requested that authority be granted to enroll at this school Louis Palin, a one-eighth blood member of the Flathead Tribe, twenty-two years of age, who has recently returned to Carlisle from his home in Montana for the express purpose of qualifying for selection when an opportunity is again given to students at this school to enter the Ford Motor Company's shops at Detroit, Michigan, to take up the course of work offered in that establishment.

Palin was enrolled at this school at the request of Superintendent Morgan of the Flathead Agency in 1910 and was a student here until April of 1914. The records at this school show that he had an entirely satisfactory record.


As it is not likely that any other student will have to be deprived of coming to Carlisle if Louis Palin is enrolled, and it is his desire to leave the school as soon as arrangements can be made for him to begin his work in the Ford Company's shops I respectfully recommend that the re-
