76977-17 Referring to your letter of August 18, asking that Carlisle Outing pupils be not called in to school this fall, you are advised that your request was submitted to the Superintendent of Carlisle School asking him to report on the matter. His answer dated September 1, says that he has recalled this fall from the farm outing homes very nearly all the boys believing that it is best for them to attend school at Carlisle, taking the work as outlined in the new course of study if they wish eventually to get a Carlisle diploma, and for this reason he has had to deny many applicants, including you, for boys to work on farms. It therefore appears that you have been definitely advised in regard to this matter by the Superintendent of Carlisle school.



Replying, I have to advise that this fall, we have recalled from their farm outing homes very nearly all the boys, believing that it is best for them to attend school here taking the work as outlined in the new course, if they wished eventually to get a Carlisle diploma. For this reason we have had to deny many applicants for boys, among them the McEwens.


