Lizzie Kemp, an Omaha girl, was enrolled at this school in October 1913 for a period of five years, when she was 13 years of age.

This summer, upon the request of her guardian, Mr. Harry L. Keefe, she was given permission to go home on leave.

I am just in receipt of the following letter from Mr. Keefe,-

" I am writing to you with reference to Elizabeth Kemp who is in your school. I have seen her several times since she returned and if you will arrange the proper papers for her release from her remaining there at Carlisle, I will place her in a private school. Without any reflection whatever upon Carlisle I am satisfied that the best interests of this girl will be served by placing her in another school and owing to the fact that she is backward and needs some personal attention, I think that she would better be placed in the private school for the year. This seems to be the desire of her relatives and others interested in her welfare. I therefore ask that she be relieved and the money advanced for her return be refunded. "

 In view of the above facts, I respectfully ask that I be given authority to release Lizzie Kemp from this school and return the railroad fare deposited with me by Mr. Keefe for Lizzie Kemp.
