In view of the fact that this girl has reached the fifth grade, although under age, and her father is able to pay her transportation expenses, an exception is made in her case complying with the recommendation of Supervisor Wyly and the Superintendent of Eufaula Boarding School. It is understood that she belongs to the restricted class of Five Tribes Indians.

Mrs. Melton, the Superintendent of the Eufaula Boarding School where this girl has been in attendance at school and Supervisor Wylly recommend Nellie's enrolment. May I enrol her if proper under the Declaration of Policy? Her father is able to pay transportation expenses.

In view of the early opening of school, an immediate decision is desirable.
