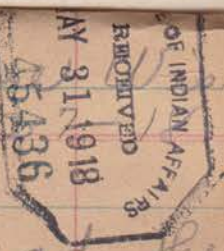

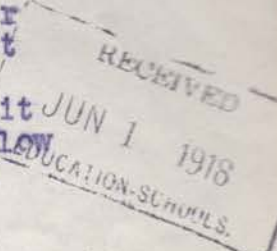

I have your letter concerning your daughter Cynthia and have found out from our school doctor, just what her trouble has been. He says that the swollen gland about which you knew, broke out again. He said, it was necessary for him to open the gland slightly to allow the discharge to drain out more readily. There was no operation.



Cynthia is attending school regularly now. I will ask the matron to watch her carefully and try to help her build up.

If you wish to have her spend her vacation with you, I would have no objection to her doing this. I sent you a Vacation Request Blank which you can sign and return to me. School closes the 6th of June, after which time, I can arrange for her to go to you, provided the money for her fare is deposited here. You will note that you have to deposit her return fare also.
