Sir:

For the reasons stated in your letter of the 12th instant,
you may expel Dick Quip, an Indian pupil from the Uintah
Reservation, from your school on account of his incorrigibility.

As he is twenty-three years of age it seems to this Office
that it is about time he was striking out and making a living
for himself. You should see that he gets back to the agency
and meanwhile notify Captain Hall that he has been expelled
and will not be permitted to enter any other Government school
without the consent of this Office.

Sir:

I respectfully report that Dick Quip, an Indian pupil from the Uintah Reservation in Utah, has repeatedly run away from school, and has caused frequent trouble by his other misconducts. He has been given repeated chances to show that he desires to improve, but has not made any effort to do so. He is twenty three years of age.

I, therefore, respectfully request that authority be granted me to expel him from this School, and recommend that he should not be allowed to enroll in any other Indian School.
