Sir:

I respectfully report that Louis Twin was taken to Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, on Saturday evening, January the 30th, and there turned over to the conductor of the Pennsylvania train over the Pan-Handle routing to Chicago. Transportation for his passage to Winnebago, Nebraska, was provided for his use.

A letter had been received here for Louis which contained something more than three dollars. That was not given to him until he left and being sufficient for his subsistence enroute only the cost of his transportation, \$29.77, will have to paid from "Indian Moneys, Proceeds of Labor, Winnebago Indians".
