Sir:

I respectfully request that authority be granted me to return Paul Kinninook, an Alaskan pupil of this school, to his home at Saxman, Alaska.

This boy was enrolled here on October 24, 1903 and is now 18 years of age. He is a brother to the girl Mary Kinninook and whose death was reported to the Office under date of December 29, 1908.

The father, grieving over the death of his girl, requests that Paul should be sent home, and in view of the facts in the case, I respectfully recommend that authority should be granted me to furnish the boy with transportation to his home.
