Sir

I have the honor
to transmit herewith descriptive statements
of 27 children, delivered to Capt R. H.
Pratt in accordance with instructions
from Office of Indian Affairs dated Sept
8. 79.

I found it impossible to raise the
required number - the feeling on the
part of the Indians being decidedly
against parting with their children.

The statement shows a lack
in children of chiefs which can be
accounted for from the fact that
our chiefs have very few children
of the required ages.
