Sir:

I have the honor to report that twenty eight (28) Children left the agency yesterday for Carlisle Penna. twenty of whom were boys and eight were girls. These belonged to the two tribes as follows.

Cheyeanne. 14 Boys 4 Girls Total 18 Arapahoes 6 Boys 4 Girls Total 10

Seeing very soon after the call was made on the Indians for children for this school, that a number far greater than was authorized would be offered, and the desire to send was so urgent, that I telegraphed your office and obtained permission to send twenty five instead of fifteen

children. As soon as the new basis was received the children were selected, care being taken to accept the most promising. After the list was fully made up, Pawnee Man, a prominent young Cheyeanne who has identified himself with the most progressive of the Agency brought his boy to me, fully clothed and prepared for school. He had purchased the clothing out of money he had earned chopping wood, and while the acceptance of his son would exceed the limit allowed, I could not refuse him. In the same manner "Gentle Horse" a brother of the celebrated "Black Kettle" who was killed in Custer's fight on the Washita in 1868, forced me to accept his boy, and Antelope, one of the returned Florida

prisoners and a member of the Agency Police force put his boy in one of the trains and it was only after the train was several miles from the Agency, that I discovered he had been smuggled in. I trust the Indian Office will authorize the sending of the additional children.
