Washington Sept. 16th 1879

The Commissioner
of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

Agreeably to the recommendation of
your letter of this date. Lieut R. H. Pratt, U. S. A.
detached as Special Agent of the Indian Service
in connection with the establishment of schools
for Indian youths, is hereby directed to assume
charge of the buildings at Carlisle, Penn. trans-
ferred to this Department by the War Department
and to establish and conduct the schools at that
point.

Authority is granted Lieut Pratt to
proceed to the Indian Territory and to Dakota
and such other places as your office may
(direct

desire, to select one hundred and twenty Indian youths to be placed in the school at Carlisle, and twenty five to fill the contract under which the school is now in operation at Hampton Va. taking with him one woman and four Indians from among those who have been in his charge as assistants, whose actual and necessary traveling expenses incident to the trip, will be charged to the proper appropriation.

Authority is also granted Lieut Poath, to pay the actual and necessary expenses that may be incurred in returning to their homes in Dakota, certain sick Indians now at Hampton Va.

Lieut Poath will be allowed his actual and necessary traveling expenses and a per diem of \$5⁰⁰ per day for subsistence while engaged in this duty.
