If Spotted Tail wants
to return his children
to Carlisle I think
he should do so at
his own expense. They
should be taught
that the children
cannot run in and
out at the cost of the

Government.

The Lemhi Indians have refused to go to
✓ Fort Hall. Agent Stone
will ask by telegraph
for instructions concerning their supplies.
Provision should be
made at once. Fort
Hall Indians are do-
ing well. They
should have fifteen
more wagons, with
harness, as soon
as possible.

I have given directions

to Agent Wright- to
issue all the cows
and calves in the
government herds
to the Indians, for
which authority
should be officially
sent to him.
