To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs  
Washington D.C.

Sir-

Referring to your letter of the 27<sup>th</sup> inst, marked "A miscellaneous, P 422, Auth 460 1880" in which the sum of \$2.35 is disallowed from my report of irregular employees for the month of February, I have the honor to explain that the sums paid, were a monthly compensation of \$5.00 and \$13.00 and \$25.00 respectively, and that in making up my report, I erred in apprehending that par. 7 on page 9 of your instructions to Agents 1877, meant that February should be held to contain 30 days, instead of coming in the whole amount into the 29 days and stating the per diem accordingly. I have the honor to transmit herewith corrected report, which I request may be substituted for the one criticised.
