Commissioner of Indian Affairs directing me to make arrangements for the lease of such land as we might need for Agricultural Industry purposes in the immediate vicinity of the Barracks I have the honor to transmit herewith Quadruplicate Agreements in each case with the heirs of Mr. G. Alexander dec<sup>d</sup> and Mr. B. K. Sams for ten and eight acres respectively. This is as much as we need for this year and the terms are as good as could be made.
