TRAINING SCHOOL FOR INDIAN YOUTH,

CARLISLE BARRACKS,

Carlisle, Pa., June 17th, 1880

Sir

When I reached here last fall with the Sioux children, I soon found that it would be impossible to manage the girls without an Interpreter as none of them could speak a word of English.

Mrs. Jennie McKangis of Rosebud Landing had asked to come here as Interpreter and Asst. Matron and bring her son. I telegraphed her to come at \$10.⁰⁰ per month and expenses. As she is about leaving, the subject of her expenses comes up for adjustment, and I request authority to cover me in the payment of \$50.⁹⁰ the amount of her claim as per the following itemized account viz-
