Dear Sir,

The pressure is getting pretty heavy on us for funds. I am under a promise to pay our beef contractor monthly. When the contract was let, the bidders combined on me and the lowest bid was \$7.⁰⁰. I determined to kill my own beef, but first visited one of the best butchers in town who had put in no bid. He stated he had intended to bid at \$6.⁰⁰ but as one of the others told him of intention to bid below that he did not bother with it, as that was as low as anyone could put in good beef for. I closed with him at \$6.⁰⁰ with above agreement.

If you can find time in your rush of work, which I know to be very heavy just now, to push forward our quarterly funds please do so.
