Complying with your letter of June 19th
I submit the following estimate of Tools and
Material, required to go ahead with Wagon
making here.

For Tools and other expenses, of fitting up
Blacksmith Shop, Wood Shop, Trimming Shop,
and Paint Shop. \$400.⁰⁰

For material to make six (6) Jump Seat
Carriages, such as I have just constructed
for our own use, and which was so much
coveted by the visiting Chiefs. \$350.⁰⁰

For material to construct six (6) light
three Spring wagons suitable for Agency
or Indian use. \$350.⁰⁰

For material to build six Team or Road
Wagons, for Indian use. \$300.⁰⁰
