CARLISLE BARRACKS,

Carlisle, Pa., August 13<sup>th</sup>, 1880

To the

Hon Commissioners of Indian Affairs  
Washington D. C.

Sir

I estimate that the Contingent expenses of this School during the Current Quarter in the purchase of Coal Oil, Matches, Lamp Fixtures, Salt, Vinegar, Dried Fruits, Postage Stamps for the Correspondence of the Pupils with Parents and Friends, Forage for Public Animals, Disinfectants, Kalsomining and White Washing and Repairing School Rooms, boys and girls Quarters, Current Repairs to all buildings and other Contingencies including Water Rent, and the rental of lots of ground from Annie J. & Laura G. Alexander and Benjamin R. Sams for one year from April 1<sup>st</sup> 1880 to March 31<sup>st</sup> 1881 both days inclusive, will amount to \$1280.<sup>00</sup>. For the expenditure of this sum in open market purchases and making the payments named from the funds already placed to my Credit I respectfully request your

authority.
