Hon Commissioner of Indian Affairs
Washington D. C.

Sir,

A limited supply of fruits, butter, eggs, milk & berries is absolutely necessary for the health of the pupils and especially so for those that are at all ailing. The authority granted in your letter of May 18, 1880 for the purchase of these articles is limited to that granted, and I respectfully request its extension, and that I be authorized to purchase during this ~~coming~~ fiscal year such of these articles of food as may be necessary in limited quantities and ^{also} authorized to pay for same with funds or my disburse or may be hereafter placed to my credit. The quantity required will not be large and it seems unnecessary to limit the authority in time so as to require its frequent renewal.
