Sir.

Through the representation of Dr. Robertson of  
Munksgaard I. I. and his daughter, and having con-  
siderable knowledge of the benefits arising from the  
annual Indian Fair - I have considered it best  
to send samples of the work of our boys to that Fair  
for exhibition to the Indians of different tribes. I have  
sent a full assortment of our Indian (3/2) day articles,  
1 Set of Double Harness, 2 Hatters, 1 pair of Smocks  
and 3 pair of repaired shoes.

I have sent these by Express in order that they might  
be there on time, and have paid the expense from my  
Charity fund. As the expense of transportation is  
material and I believe the general good of the  
service would be best served by it, I respectfully  
request you to authorize the party in Charge at
