To the Honorable
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs
Washington D. C.

Sir

Under your instructions to proceed to Green Bay, Sisseton and La Pointe Agencies for the purpose of procuring 25 children from those Agencies for this School I have to inform you that I leave here this evening and expect to reach Green Bay on Wednesday next. La Pointe on the Saturday following and the Sisseton Agency about the 24th.

I desire to remain a few days at the Sisseton Agency and return to Carlisle about the 6th November.

During my absence Mr. A. J. Standing will have charge of Affairs at the School, and carry out the work I have arranged.
