The Honorable Commissioner
of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D.C.

Sir:

With your increased number of pupils the cooking range which we purchased last winter proves too small and the vessels inadequate to the needs. I respectfully request to be allowed to purchase in open market an additional length for the range of four feet which will cost \$80. and two additional copper boilers at a cost of \$20. and \$26, respectively, making in all \$126.

We need this addition to our range now but it will be sufficient for us if we have as many as three hundred pupils.
