CARLISLE BARRACKS,

Carlisle, Pa., December 3 1880

The Honorable Commissioners  
of Indian Affairs,  
Washington, D.C.

Sir:

Referring to the authority granted by your letter of August 25<sup>th</sup> last, authorizing the admission to this school of two Indian youth to be sent here by Bishop Huntington, I have the honor to inform you that one of said youths being in very poor health was sent home almost immediately. The other is here at the school and I have received from the lady patron, \$25- as the first quarterly installment as authorized by your letter.

Shall I take up said sum as part of the charity fund of the school or use it accordingly or will you <sup>order</sup> other disposition of it.

I find it difficult to raise the needed amount to complete the payment for the steam heat eng. This amount received as charity might go to the charities that I receive for

that purpose.
