For the first quarter of 1881, we shall need to expend in open market purchases, \$1100. for the following purposes, Coal oil, Matches, Lamps & lamp fixtures, Salt, Dried fruit, Brooms, School supplies, Postage stamps for the correspondence of pupils with parents & friends, Forage for public animals, Disinfectants, Gum, & needed repairs to buildings, &c; Materials for the manufacture of wagons, harness, tinware, &c; & for freight on supplies received & also on our manufactured articles shipped to agencies.

I would respectfully request your authority to expend this amount in open market as stated
