The Honorable Commissioners
of Indian Affairs,

Sir:

We very much need for the cleanliness of the
boys' beds, spreads which can be washed by thus save
us from washing blankets. I find that the ordinary
hospital spread of dark striped linen is probably the
most durable of bed that we could get for that purpose.

If we can have three hundred of them it will en-
able us to keep them clean and always have spreads on the
beds. I find the bed will cost \$1.50 each. I respectfully
request your authority to purchase in open mar-
ket that number at a total cost not to exceed \$450.
