Walter Komah has only \$37.95 to his credit here. He spends his money as fast as he receives it from home. We do not require them to save their home money. He had \$50.00 in March which is all gone. We require them to save half of what they earn. I think your better way would be to get some lawyer to write him a very sharp letter and threaten to haul him up before the court. Your bill is returned.
