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Wear in ^{heel of} your boots next to socks
a plate of copper ^{and} of zinc.

From an ordinary sheet of copper, cut
a plate of this shape **D** to fit the
heel of boot inside. Wear copper
plate in one boot, zinc plate in the
other, ^{and} keep on wearing them. The
slight electric current does the work.
Don't laugh but try it.
