① We are ready for the girls - having finished off some excellent rooms for them in Va. Hall.

I have planned a fine building for the boys - cost about \$11,000.00 - Cribs all made - no time to be wasting around - back to architecture of Indian. Not as I imagined

one of Indian please telegraph me here at Stockbridge Mass.

"You may ask ~~about~~ about (State no.) boys and about (no.) girls;" so important about girls - not over 25 boys you know as we can't provide enough for more.

As soon I hear definitely the said order of Hampton to go ahead on Indian building. You telegraphed & written & waited till the building is done, probably before
