too. ~~Both~~ Both I had get in
there I make five Indian
boys on the farm. to make
Sunday noon I take boat
and cross river it was
very deep. I want a boat
just go down. I go about
half month. and repair
boat in water. I had a good
strong. Indian boys fall
down in the water.
