5. Tell something of your present home I live in a house at Ft. Apache have a sewing machine, stove; and cooking utensils.

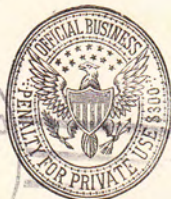
6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings, or money do you have? I have 16 horses, 15 head of cattle; a farm of 10 acres, all under cultivation.
