I went to Phoenix Indian School trying to attend school, but I am little too high for the school, that was in 1900.

4. What is your present occupation?

I am acting as Indian interpreter, for the present, here in Globe.

5. Tell something of your present home

I have no place which to be call a home. I have little place about 75 miles from here.

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings, or money do you have?

I have a house on the Reservation.

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each?

I have been U. S. Special Police here in Globe. Suppressing the intoxicating liquor ^{traffic} among the Indians, but I quit the job two months ago, on account of the wages to small for ^{profits} danger for me.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? I am Blacksmithing
a great deal around here, also boiler-making.
I was assisting fore-man trucking logging for a year.

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

I was U.S. Special Police, here, for some time.
I just like to have Indian Department-Indian service to
appoint me as U.S. officer here.
There are too much intoxicating liquor traffics among the
Indians which make them poor all the times.
It's no good to have a white ^{man} officer here, because they
don't really know the Indian way.
Because, they have a U.S. constable here, he caught
lots of boot-leggers through me, he got a good name
and got promoted, and I get nothing. I do not want
make some body else a name, I want for myself.
I am Carlisle, I want your people to help me to have
the gov. appoint as U.S. officer here.
I am located in Globe. If you willing to help me write
to me and let me know.
