10. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? *I got this work from the Government 2 days after I got home from Carlisle. This ended. Then I got a job in the store at Riverton. worked till the store closed. Then I was at the mines for some time. Just before this I got.*

11. Have you done anything for the betterment of your people? Write fully.

Just a lot of my people ~~are~~ are outside of the Reservation and had no water right for their land and I had been 3 years trying to get water for them and now these last few weeks I heard from my Agent I was going to get it this spring. And they are all glad about it. They said they could never get it if it had not been for me for they ~~try~~ tried and tried but could ~~not~~ make no success

Then I thought I would try and see if I could do any help and I was just about getting tired but finally got ^{permit} to started it.

12. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life.

I had been pretty study on ~~nothing~~ ^{job} since I came back home. and I have kept pretty honest. as the people in Town. think I am the only honest Indian they ever had seen.

This is one of the main point I try to keep. to be honest, and Industrious at any thing to keep my jobs. I was at the Coal mines as a contractor till I was called ~~for~~ by P. E. He says to be his clerk as a bookkeeper in store.

Where I am now. I will stay just for a while then I will try my own land again which I hope to make a success. I aim to stick to it. and have a home of my own. as though I am single but any way I will have it already in good way.

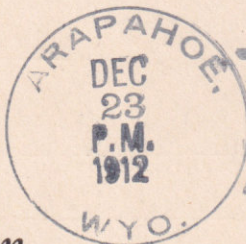

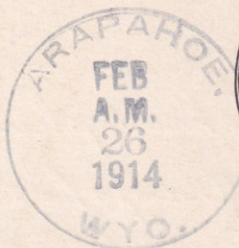
