Entered Carlisle in August 1896
Returned home in August 1899.

Went to Fargo, North Dak. Agricultural College
in the fall of 1900 and returned home 1903.

4. What is your present occupation? Blacksmithing and Farming.

5. Tell something of your present home I have a granary, well house,
horse stable, cattle barn, chicken house, wagon
shed, blacksmith shop, ice house and four roomed house.

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings or money do you have? I have 240
acres, 16 head of cattle, 18 head of horses, 2 wagons, 1 spring
buggy, and 1 single buggy.
4 roomed house, farm machinery and have little money in
the bank.

I have been working in Blacksmith 2 years, also
worked in the office as Asst. Clerk for one (1)
year.
