Dear Friends:

I have received your letter of the 17th instant and must state in reply thereto that I do not know in what way I could assist you to establish tribal rights because I do not have any information at command regarding you except that our records contain the information that Mr. DeWitt was reported to be a Cherokee when he came to Carlisle.

The fact that he was accepted here as a student would not constitute evidence sufficient to establish his rights, as a number of students are enrolled here who do not have any tribal rights.

It is my suggestion that you take what evidence you have to Superintendent Green of the Shawnee Agency or direct to Superintendent Parker of the Five Civilized Tribes at Muskogee.

later he received a letter
with a card which you
wanted him to fill out
and asked him the
name he was married
under and how many
children he had if
any. And said you heard
from over 2000 of the
scholars that had been
to school there once
a year. And that you
would like to hear
from him once a year
if no more. And that you
also had helped so many to
get their land and right help.

Now we certainly
 would be grateful to you
 if you could assist us
 in getting ours for their
 in Cherokee one my
 side as well as his.

As I know for a fact
 My Great Grandfather
 name is on the Roll
 A. Fry his Name was
 Abraham - that is on
 my mother's side and
 he lived in Ch. there
 is an old couple here
 that have seen him
 many times and know
 that he was Indian.
 You will find Mr
 Hewitt's name listed
 there

you could help us
 in any way it certainly
 would be appreciated very
 much so hoping you
 will please excuse this
 liberty I am taking
 as we knew no one
 else could tell us as
 well as you so hope
 to hear from you soon
