Among these are understood to be Alfrich Heap-of-Birds, White Shield, Old Crow, Wolf Chief, William Little Chief, Buffalo Thigh, Thunder Bull and Scabby.

It is probable that some of the Darlington Indians and also a few

Kiowas will join the party.
