There has always been and as long as life last will be a warm place in my heart for the Carlisle Pa. School and all its teachers and pupils. These sweet memories is deep down in my heart and will never die so long as I live. May Heavens Blessing be upon that school its founders teachers and pupils forever. Many sorrows and disappointments at times has come in my past life. but when my memory goes back to the Carlisle School its teachers and pupils my heart is made to leap with joy. I am 48 years old I am living near Clinton Water County Oklahoma on my allotment with my wife and children I am sending my children to the public schools and as soon

as I can I shall send Se Clinton, C them to The Carlisle School Pa knowing what it has done for me I know it will do the same for my children I am doing the best I know in this world I am living a Christian life and say no bad words drink no whiskey play no cards or use tobacco in any way Carlisle School did all this for me I wish I had the tongue to speak and tell all my people why the benefits I have received from the Carlisle School in Pa. I feel that I have a good clean record in that school and as I am asking the government to remove all my restrictions so I can be and feel free to do as I please with all my private affairs I wish you to send to me a certified copy of my record in the 6 years I was in school then no more fear I may worry your patience please allow me to say from the depths of my heart may all the blessings of Heaven forever be and rest upon the founders teachers and pupils of the Carlisle School of Pa.

He had two summer outings and one winter outing while here and made a very good record each time.

His record at the school, during his two terms, was very good. He was employed as scout for a time after his return to the Agency in 1884.
