This is to Certify, THAT, *Stanley Little Whiteman*

who was regularly committed to the Montana State Reform School, and who has been an inmate of said Reform School for a period of more than one year, during all of which time the said

Stanley Little Whiteman has deported *him* self in such a manner as to make it reasonably probable that the said *Stanley Little Whiteman* has reformed and is

a proper person to be discharged, and the Director of the said Reform School, having recommended to the Board of Trustees of said school, that the said *Stanley Little Whiteman*

be discharged on trial or parole.

It is now, therefore ordered that the said *Stanley Little Whiteman* be and is hereby released from the said Reform School on parole, under the provisions of Section 3,093 of the Penal Code.

This however, is ordered, and parole given, upon the express conditions that the said *Stanley Little Whiteman* will, as often as once in each month, till he arrives at the age of twenty-one years, write to the Director of said School and report *his* conduct,

and if required so to do, by the said Director, shall furnish to the said Director a certificate of good behavior from *his* parents or guardian, or employer, as the case may be; and it is made a further condition of this release and parole, that the Director of said Reform School may at any time recall and cause to have returned to the said Reform School the said *Stanley Little Whiteman*

if in the opinion of the said Director, from any information he may have, the said *Stanley Little Whiteman* is not conducting *him* self properly, or has not a suitable home.

In witness whereof, we, the said Board of Trustees of the Montana State Reform School, have hereunto set our hands this *22nd* day of *Nov.* 190*6*
