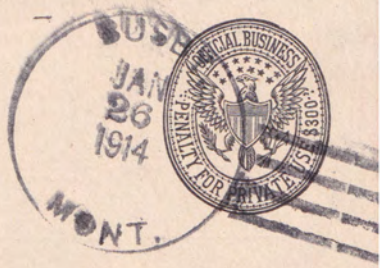
PHYSICIAN'S CERTIFICATE.

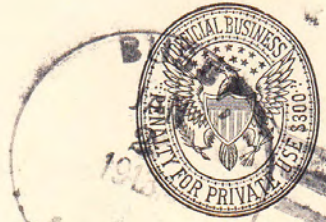
