I thank you very much that you feel like helping me something. I got all what I can do under this Agency where I have been the last eighteen years as an employee. This Agent has been helping me; he has done all he could for me in assisting me, but it may be that the time will come where I shall be glad to call on you for help.

I wonder if you could send me an officer's pass, such as we used to wear; it has yellow stripes on it. I would like to have one to keep as a souvenir, to be size 40 - 33
