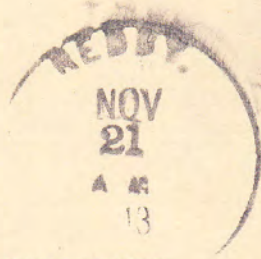
Subt. Tipps.
