11. Have you done anything for the betterment of your people? Write fully. I am one to help my people all the time. When they have a big council I always get up and make a talk for my people, I try to be fair to both the agency employees and the Indians. I always do the best I can.

12. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life. While at Carlisle I received a bad injury in my knee from which I have never regained the proper use.
