I did not stay very long at Carlisle, but I wished I had. However I am sending my boy to the day school at 10 years old so that he may learn all he can, and handle his legal affairs right. Last fall I shipped good many head of cattle and I received a good sum of money which is drawing interest in a bank. There had not been any irrigating ditch on my land I have been dry farming raising hay and have gotten along very nicely. I have a two room frame house and live comfortably. In the way of farming implements I have just bought a good many new ones and paid good prices for all. My father, Crazy Head, was one of the chiefs of our Tribe, since his death I have filled his place, and have my own District to look after. This is all I wish to say.
