4. What is your present occupation? Stock raising and farming.

5. Tell something of your present home My present home is at the foot of the "Little Rockies" -situated at the south end of the reservation - forty-five miles from the agency. A stage line passes my place.

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings, or money do you have? Have about 60 acres of land under cultivation, raise oats, alfalfa and garden truck; own 40 head of cattle and 130 head of horses; 4 ranch buildings and corrals.

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each? Yes, Teamster at the Fort Belknap Agency, 3 years; Stockman same agency, 1 year.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?.....
